

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on **October 12, 2021**, the City Council of the City of Fillmore, California, introduced an Ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FILLMORE, CALIFORNIA, ADDING CHAPTER 8.10 TO TITLE 8 (“HEALTH AND SANITATION”) OF THE FILLMORE MUNICIPAL CODE, ENTITLED “SPECIFIC REGULATIONS FOR ORGANICS WASTE DISPOSAL, REDUCTION, RECYCLING, AND SOLID WASTE COLLECTION,” TO ENACT REGULATIONS IN COMPLIANCE WITH SENATE BILL (SB) 1383 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF FOOD AND ORGANICS RECYCLING AND RELATED SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING PROCESSING AND REPORTING AND ADOPTION OF AN EXEMPTION FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

The proposed Ordinance (Ordinance No. 21-934) will amend Title 8 of the Fillmore Municipal Code (FMC) and add a new Chapter 8.10 to enact regulations for organics waste disposal reduction, recycling, and solid waste collection and adopt an exemption from CEQA to comply with Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383). The Ordinance will mandate organic waste generators, haulers, and other entities subject to SB 1383 regulations to comply with the SB 1383 regulations set forth in FMC Chapter 8.10. The Ordinance includes requirements for generators to participate in organic waste collection programs or self-haul organic waste to processing; multi-family and business owners and property managers to support organic waste disposal reduction; commercial edible food generators to recover edible food through contracts or written agreements with food recovery organizations and services; and certain recordkeeping, contamination monitoring, procurement, and public outreach/education requirements.

The City Council will conduct a second reading and consider the adoption of Ordinance No. 21-934 on November 09, 2021.
